

What to Bring...?

Have all medications with you at registration. They are to be turned in at check in. DO NOT PACK THEM.

Pack the Items Below and Mark them with your Name:

- ___ Bedroll: sleeping bag or 2 sheets & blankets, pillow
- ___ Flashlight with new batteries.
- ___ Toiletries: soap, toothbrush & toothpaste, brush, comb, etc.
- ___ Towels & washcloths
- ___ Clothing:
 - ___ shirts
 - ___ jeans and shorts
 - ___ socks and underwear (bring extra socks)
 - ___ 2 pairs of old shoes (please no sandals or jellies)
 - ___ warm jacket or sweatshirt (nights are chilly in camp)
 - ___ pajamas
 - ___ rain gear
 - ___ swimsuit and towel
- ___ Bible (Bibles are available at camp if you do not have one.)
- ___ Insect repellent (stick or bottle - try not to bring spray)
- ___ Dirty Clothes Bag
- ___ Camera, books, stationary/stamps (optional)

DO NOT BRING:

Radios or compact disk players, TV, walkman, Gameboy, I-pod / MP3 player or other electronic games, jewelry, fireworks, firearms, pets, food, gum, candy/snacks, alcohol, tobacco or any other drug, pocket knives or any other weapon.

How to Get to Beaver Creek Camp

Overnighter Camp (2 days/1 night)

July 31 – Aug. 1

Campers who have completed kindergarten or first grade spend the night at camp with mom or dad. This is an opportunity for our youngest campers and their parent to find out what church camp is all about. Grouping in activities will allow for parents to spend some time with their child and also to spend some time with other parents. This will be a time for youngsters to explore who and what God means to them. Pre-Junior II Camp (3 days/2 nights)

July 27-29

Campers who have completed grade 2, 3, or 4 will enjoy swimming, crafts, games, Bible lessons and exploring nature. This camp offers three whole days of learning about God and yourself while making many new friends. Check in at 10:00 a.m. on the first day and return for home at 7:00 p.m. on day three.

Cost: \$105.00/camper

Junior Camp (6 days/5 nights)

July 6-11

Campers who have completed grade 5 or 6 spend a full week at camp seeing old friends and meeting new ones. They will learn more about what God calls us to be through Bible study, nature, large and small group activities. Campers will swim, hike, play and create crafts. Check in between 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday and stay until 7:00 p.m. on Friday.

Cost: \$190.00/camper

Junior High Camp (6 days/5 nights)

July 12-17

Campers who have completed grade 7, 8, or 9 are getting older and will have new experiences, exciting challenges and a lot of good times. Come be a part of it all with new friends and old, while discovering more and more about yourself and God. Check in between 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday and stay until 7:00 p.m. on Friday.

Cost: \$190.00/camper

Opportunity Camp (6 days/5 nights)

July 20-24

Opportunity Camp is sponsored by individuals, local churches and their organizations, and other mission contributions intended to provide an "opportunity" for children who would otherwise never attend summer camp. For many on these youth, Opportunity Camp provides the first exposure to God's love and the saving grace in Jesus Christ. For over thirty years, Opportunity Camp has brought 25-55 youth to camp for a week each summer. Registration for this camp is based upon recommendation according to need and the target age is 10 to 12. 3. **Medical Forms** may be sent with registration or at a later date. All campers must have a current Medical Form on file at camp at the start of the camp he/she attends. If the Medical Form is sent in advance of camp, the medications section may need to be updated when your camper checks in. All medications are to be turned in to the camp director upon arrival at camp. No medicines, except inhalers, are to be are to be packed, carried by the camper, or stored in cabins.
4. **Register by June 1, and receive a \$10.00 discount per camper.**
(Applies only to camp fees at or above \$105.00)
5. An additional \$10.00 will be discounted for second members attending camp from the same family (Except for the Overnighter).
6. Returning campers can **Bring a Friend for Free** who is attending Beaver Creek Camp for the first time. (Must Register by June 1, 2009)
7. Include the enclosed form to **pre-order your camp T-Shirt.**
(Camp T-Shirt cost - \$15.00)
